

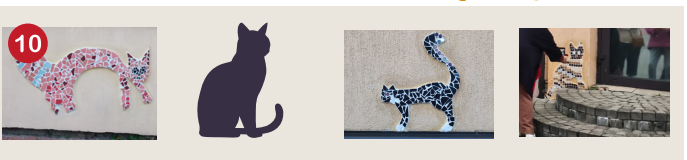
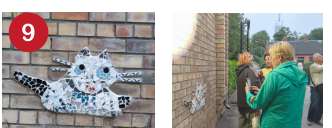
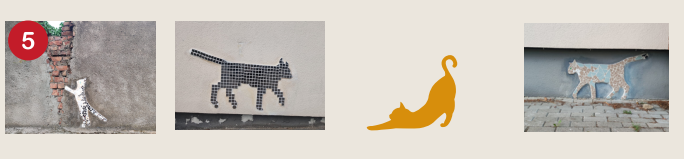
EXPLORE THE CATS IN BAUSKA

EXPLORE THE SMALL STREETS OF BAUSKA

The mosaic creation began with cat drawings, mostly made by children. In open workshops, participants used these drawings to create mosaics on jute fabric, which were then attached to the building walls. The process emphasized the use of suitable and natural materials. Attaching the mosaics to the buildings also visually improved the walls themselves.

The inspiration for the mosaics came from the ginger cats living in the Town Hall Square – Rūdis and Ķipis.

During the walk, it is also possible to discover local businesses along the "Cats in Bauska" route – the restaurant "Harvest House", the flower shop "Rozīte", the bike rental and repair shop "Velo sēta", the fitness club "Mogo", the shopping center "Kvēle", and within it, the Latvian-made products store "Spulga".
