

IECAVA PARK UN MANOR COMPLEX



The park is an architectural monument of national importance. It was established together with the construction of the manor complex, between 1795 and 1800, in the style as a naturalistic English landscape park. The total area of the park is 16.6 hectares. During the walk, it is possible to see such Great trees as beech, larch, linden, Pennsylvanian ash, cedar and oak. Trees can be dated up to 130 years old! Upon prior application, it is possible to go on a guided tour of the park.

VECUMNIEKI



One of the oldest Great trees in Vecumnieki is located near the bridge of the Talke river - a fragile willow - one of the checkpoints of the Vecumnieki Orienteering is located at its foot. While walking around the village, visitors can find also several other Great trees - The Great oaks.

KURMENE MANOR AND PARK



The park includes the buildings of the ancient manor complex, for a leisurely rest and walk - you can see several open-air animal aviaries (alpacas, llamas, ostriches, exotic birds), a ceramic kiln, St. Peter's Catholic Church, as well as several large trees.

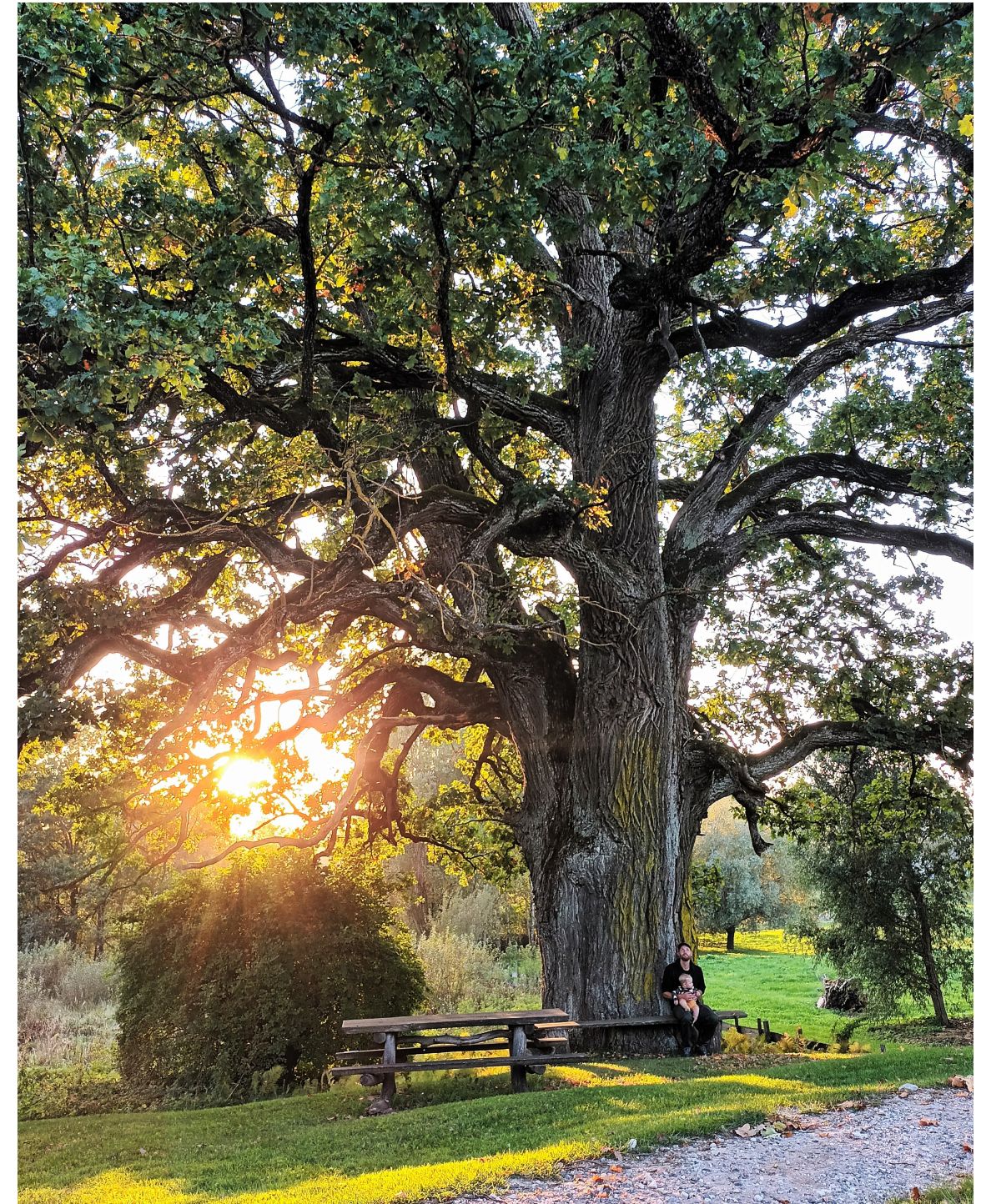
ĀNE - MĒMELES PARK



Is located on the banks of the Mēmele river, at the very border of Latvia. The park was established in the 19th century as an English landscape park, right next to the Ānmēmele manor which belonged to the Baron von Hahn family (the manor could be seen only from the outside!). In the park, Great trees with storks' nests, flower and herb beds, a recreation area as well as an open-air exhibition of paintings can be viewed.

SVITENE MANOR PARK



Svitene manor's castle is built in 19th century and it is one of the most outstanding classicism examples in Zemgale region. Right next to the building a manor park has been established, visitors are welcome to explore Great trees - Great Oaks, as well as neogothic chapel of the von Elmpt family - the former owners of the manor.

RUNDĀLE PALACE GARDEN AND PARK



The park and garden were established together with the construction of the palace; during the times restored, preserving the original plan of the architect F. Rastrelli. Now visitors can see here the characteristic elements - the ornamental parterre, fountain, bosquets, pavilions, Great trees such as ash tree, horse-chestnut tree, oak, apple trees and more.

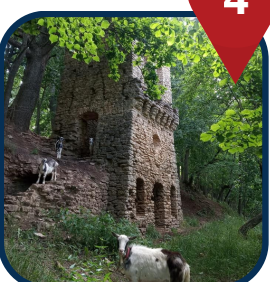
MEŽOTNE HILLFORT AND CHURCH



Is located on the left bank of Lielupe, opposite of Mežotne Castle. The hillfort is one of the largest fortifications of the ancient semigallians (dated about 9th - 13th centuries). In the area between the Mežotne hillfort and so-called Vīnakalns, the old town spread over an area of 13 hectares. Next to the hillfort the Mežotne church is located.

Great trees such as oak, horse chestnut, and elm can be found in this area. The Great linden tree can be found on the other side of the shore, in the territory of Mežotne Castle.

JUMPRAVMUIŽA PARK



It is one of the most romantic manor parks in Latvia, located on the rocky coast of Lielupe with a terrain uncharacteristic of Zemgale - dolomite rock outcrops, ravines, springs, streams and even a small waterfall. The establishment of the park began at the end of the 18th century, based on the century romantic aesthetics. Several Great trees such as oaks, lindens and robinias - speak about the history of the place.

BAUSKA CITY GREAT TREES. KARP GARDEN



Several Great trees can be found in the urban area, including white robinias (along Plūdoņa 50/52, Kalēju, Dārza and Zaļā streets), oaks and lindens - several of them located in the territory of the Bauska Nature park.

The Korf garden was historically formed thanks to the Polish-Lithuanian nobleman F. Karp, who owned several properties and territories in Bauska. It is possible to go for a walk in the garden through walking paths; children can go to playgrounds, and visitors are welcome to see the Great Oak. During the holidays, the garden is lightened in thematic colors.
